

Cool Summer Salad Recipe

Before you start up the grill or head out to the beach, whip up a cool salad to enjoy this summer.

Broccoli salad

Use a shredding disk of food processor for an easy way to shred broccoli stalks and florets (about 1 large head). Chop or finely dice 1/2 of red onion and add it to bowl with broccoli. Add 3/4 cup sliced almonds and 1/3 cup of dried cranberries - toss to mix.

Make dressing with 1 cup mayonnaise, 2 Tablespoons of lemon juice, 2 Tablespoons of rice vinegar, 1/2 teaspoon of kosher salt, freshly ground pepper to taste, and 1/2 cup of granulated sugar. *sugar can be reduced. Whisk to combine ingredients into a smooth dressing.

Pour dressing over broccoli/vegetable mix and fold in to cover completely. Refrigerate 30 minutes before serving. Garnish with cooked & chopped bacon pieces.


